

CHRONOLOGY OF HOLY WEEK

PALM SUNDAY	Triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem – Mt. 21:1-11, 14-16 Jesus retires to Bethany for the night. Note – Jesus never stayed overnight in Jerusalem.
MONDAY	Jesus casts out the sellers & dealers from the temple – Mk. 11:15-18
TUESDAY	Jesus returns to the temple: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• His authority is questioned by the chief priests and Scribes – Mk. 11:27-33• Parable of two sons – Mt. 21:29-32• Parable of vine dressers – Mt. 21:33-46• Parable of the marriage feast – Mt. 22:1-14• Question of Tribute to Caesar – Mt. 22:15-22• Question of the Resurrection – Mt. 22:23-33• Question of the great commandment – Mt. 22:34-40• Lament over Jerusalem – Mt. 23:37-39• Hypocrisy of the Scribes and Pharisees – Mt. 23:1-36• Foretelling of the destruction of Jerusalem and the temple – Mt. 24:1-20• End of the world – Mt. 24:21-25, 29-31• Last Judgment – Mt. 25:31-46
WEDNESDAY	Judas makes pact to betray Jesus – Mt. 26:1-5, 14-16
HOLY THURSDAY	Preparation for the Passover meal – Lk. 22:7-13 Last Supper <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Passover meal – Lk. 22:14-18• Washing of feet – John 13:1-20• Institution of the Eucharist & Priesthood – Lk. 22:19-20

CHRONOLOGY OF HOLY WEEK, Cont'd

- Peter's denial foretold – Lk. 22:31-34
- Promise of the Holy Spirit – John 14:1-31
- Union with Christ (Vine & Branches) – John 15:1-17
- Their persecution foretold – John 15:18-27, 16:1-5
- Necessity of Jesus' departure; role of the Advocate; Joy after sorrow – John 16:6-23
- Christ's priestly prayer for unity – John 17:1-26
 - Pray for Himself – John 17:1-5
 - Prays for the Disciples – John 17:6-19
 - Prays for the faithful – John 17:20-26
- Jesus and Apostles enter the Garden of Gethsemani where Jesus is arrested – Lk. 22:39-53

FIRST HEARING BEFORE SANHEDRIN

Late Thursday night:

- Jesus is brought before Annas, ex-High Priest, Father-in-Law of Caiphas who was High Priest. Annas still wielded great influence and probably occupied the same residence as Caiphas – John 18:13
- Jesus before Caiphas and the Sanhedrin – Mark 14:53-64
- Jesus is imprisoned overnight in the palace of Caiphas

SECOND HEARING BEFORE SANHEDRIN

Early Friday morning:

JESUS BEFORE PILATE – John 18:28

JESUS BEFORE HEROD – Luke 23:6-12

JESUS SENT BACK TO PILATE – Lk. 23:13-16; Mt. 27:15-30; Jn. 19:4-

JESUS IS CRUCIFIED – LK. 23:26-32; MK. 15:22-25; JN. 19:18-22

THE SEVEN LAST WORDS OF JESUS:

- “Father, forgive them for they know not what they do.” - Lk. 23:34
- Promise of Paradise to the good thief. - Lk 23:39-43
- “Woman, behold, your Son. “ Then he said to the disciple, “Behold, your mother.” - Jn 19:25-27
- “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?” - Mk 15:33-35
- “I Thirst.” - Jn 19:28-29
- “It is finished.” - Jn 19:30
- “Father, into your hands I commend my spirit;” - Lk 23:46

THE BURIAL OF JESUS – John 19:38-42

EASTER SUNDAY - Day of the Resurrection

- The empty tomb - Mk 16:1-8
- The 3 women tell the Apostles – Lk 24:9-11
- Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene - John 20:3-20
